FREE, SELF-GUIDED CORONADO TOURS

Emerald Keepers celebrates Coronado's history and natural beauty with free self-guided audio tours for all ages to enjoy a walk on the beach or bike ride down the Silver Strand.


Download the VoiceMap app on your phone and create an account selecting the city of San Diego. VoiceMap's audio tour app uses GPS to play audio automatically, at the right time and place.

Bring your headphones for these entertaining and educational guides to Coronado.

WALKING TOUR **Golden Sands and Pristine Beaches**

Start at the top of the steps at Stan's Beach by the Coronado Shores and walk the 1.5-mile stretch of beach ending at North Beach. Listen to stories about a local shipwreck, the Hotel Del Coronado,

and two beachfront Navy bases Learn about the ocean, flora and



you can protect and care for our beaches and ocean. Plan for approximately 35 minutes to complete the tour although

you can stop at any time to enjoy points along the way.

BIKING TOUR The Bayshore Bikeway

Starting at the Coronado Boathouse, discover treasures along the flat Bayshore Bikeway. Pedal past Glorietta Bay Park, Delta Beach, and Crown Cove before ending at the Loews Coronado Bay Resort. 4.3-miles from the start. On the 40-minute ride



you'll hear about the area's history, and the flora and fauna of San Diego Bay, including the endangered least tern bird and Eastern Pacific green sea turtle. Feel free to stop and pause the app at any time to savor the sites on the tour.
