## ZERO WASTE CONCERTS IN THE PARK

Let's hear it for bringing back Concerts in the Park, but let's not bring back waste and litter! It is time to rethink your concert picnic. Here are some ideas:

### RETHINK

Rethink old habits. Choose the can over the plastic bottle. Bring a reusable water bottle and use the water refilling station located at the park. The City has installed water filling stations all around town.

Avoid single-use plastics. Our planet is drowning in plastic—plastic in the ocean, landfills, parks, air, along our highways, on our beaches, and even in our food. Please consider something other than plastic (paper and cloth bags, beeswax or silicone bags, cloth, metal containers, mason jars, etc.).

### REDUCE

Reduce the amount of waste you create. Challenge yourself to pack a waste-free picnic every concert.
